

Opening wooden aluminium windows, MSEAL and MSAL

A modern and durable solution that is suitable for construction and renovation projects in both modern and traditional settings.

Structure

Our opening windows are double-glazed and open inwards. The outer sash and outer cladding are made from powder-coated aluminium.

Sealing

The windows are triple sealed. The inner sash and frame have groove gaskets. On the outer sash, the frame aluminium cladding is sealed all the way from top to bottom with small breaks in the sealing left at the sides for ventilation.

Glazing

The inner sash of the MSEAL window holds an insulated double glass pane and the outer sash holds a float glass pane. In the MSAL window, both sashes feature a float glass pane.

Fixed wooden aluminium windows, HRAL 3K and 2K

Fixed windows offer a larger glass surface and convenience in everyday life, with only two surfaces to clean.

Glazing

These fixed windows are glazed with double or triple-insulated glazing, containing argon gas and a low-e finish as standard.

Opening wooden windows, MSE and MS

Traditional wooden frame windows untreated or treated according to the customer's wishes. Our treated windows are always triple sealed. The relevant hardware is included in the price.

Unpainted windows are treated with water-soluble wood preserver which protects the wood from decay, blue stain and mould for approximately one year. In MS windows that have been coated with a protective agent, sealing and the relevant hardware are available as additional features.

Fixed wooden frame windows, MEK 3K and 2K

Treated windows

Clear protective coating, translucent coating, paint and dual colour coatings.

Glazing

These fixed wooden frame windows are glazed with double or triple-insulated glazing, containing argon gas and a low-e finish as standard.

Depth of frame

96, 131, 175 and 220mm
The depth of frame varies slightly depending on the type of window selected.

Additional features

Removable grids, blinds, insect screens, fresh air valves and special glazing.

VILLA 1.0

A solid, double-sealed wooden door that keeps the cold at bay. The Villa 1.0 is suitable for standard houses and holiday homes, and can be used as both an external door and a balcony door. U-values: glass doors: from 1.0 W/m²K, solid doors: 0.95 W/m²K.

VILLA 1.3

A solid double-sealed wooden door for holiday homes. The Villa 1.3 provides excellent thermal insulation and is suitable for three-season holiday homes. U-value: 1.3 W/m²K (with standard glazing).

A lipped cabin door for saunas, with the emphasis on a traditional, natural style. The door's frame is 40 mm thick and panelled on both sides with 12 mm thick panels. The door is supplied untreated and should therefore be treated after installation to provide optimal weatherproofing.
